What is ReShare





ReShare is a REsource SHARE-ing system

For FLO, ReShare will allow libraries to lend books to one another since you no longer share an ILS.





The Onboarding Process

what's going to happen?





Here's What's Going To Happen

- First, we're going to set up your ReShare system!
 - We've got everything we need to do this-nothing for you to worry about!
- Next, we're going to bring each individual institution on board.
 - We'll need some information to help us get set up
 - We'll do some testing to make sure everything is working.
- We'll set up VuFind so patrons will be able to make requests
- We'll set up Metadb for reporting
- We'll do training so everyone knows how to use the system
- We'll flip the switch and go live on August 5th, 2024

Month-by-Month

- May
 - ReShare system set up
- June
 - Implementation sheets filled out
 - Individual libraries brought online
 - VuFind Intake
- July
 - VuFind customizations and final set up
 - Testing and training
- August
 - Launch!
